

**TOWN OF GENESEE
LIQUOR LICENSE HEARING
CONDUCTED BY THE TOWN BOARD
June 10, 2019
MINUTES**

Leair called the meeting to order at 5:45 p.m. Present were Supervisors Morris, Schmittinger, Houston and Ross. Also present were Planner/Administrator Herrmann and Clerk Majeskie.

**Discussion/action "Class A" Intoxicating and Fermented Malt Beverage Licenses
Genesee Gas Inc.**

Houston made a motion to approve Genesee Gas Inc. for a "Class A" Intoxicating and Fermented Malt beverage license with the following standard conditions, seconded by Ross. The motion passed unanimously.

Standard Liquor license conditions

1. Noise from patrons, entertainment and devices shall be kept at a reasonable level.
2. Any time a written complaint is received by the Town the owner shall be notified by the Town within 15 days with a copy of the complaint.
3. If licensee shall fail to comply with, or shall violate any of the above restrictions and conditions, the Town Board may, by resolution, revoke or suspend this license after a revocation hearing and upon due notice to licensee and a determination by the Town Board on the question of revocation.

Discussion/action- "Class B" and "Reserved Class B" Intoxicating Liquor and Fermented Malt Beverage License's-

Houston made a motion to approve the following "Class B" and "Reserved Class B" Intoxicating Liquor and Fermented Malt Beverage License's with the standard condition listed below, seconded by Ross. The motion passed unanimously.

Wales-Genesee Lions Club- Highway 83
Wern Valley Sportsmen Club- Wern Way
Sideliners Pub and Grill - Commercial Drive
Ten Chimneys Foundation- Depot Road (reserved license)**

Standard Liquor license conditions

1. Noise from patrons, entertainment and devices shall be kept at a reasonable level.
2. Any time a written complaint is received by the Town the owner shall be notified by the Town within 15 days with a copy of the complaint.
3. If licensee shall fail to comply with, or shall violate any of the above restrictions and conditions, the Town Board may, by resolution, revoke or suspend this license after a revocation hearing and upon due notice to licensee and a determination by the Town Board on the question of revocation.

Vittles and Vine Hwy. 83

Ross made a motion to approve the following "Class B" Intoxicating Liquor and Fermented Malt Beverage License's with the standard liquor license conditions and the condition that all consumption of alcoholic beverages on the deck/gazebo and patio area shall cease at 10:00 p.m. Sunday -Thursday and at 10:30 p.m. on Friday and Saturday, seconded by Houston. The motion passed unanimously.

Elias Public House Inc. - Highway 18

Houston made a motion to approve the following "Class B" Intoxicating Liquor and Fermented Malt Beverage License's with the standard liquor license conditions and the following extra conditions listed below, seconded by Ross. The motion passed unanimously.

1. Alcohol may be served during regular team games and tournaments, with no consumption after 11:00 p.m. in the volleyball area.
2. Sold by licensed Elias Public house bartenders only, from the container east of Mickle Road.
3. Subject to site plan and plan of operations being approved by the Town of Genesee Plan Commission.
4. Alcoholic beverages covered under this license may be transported from the main building to the volleyball area.

InCahoots and Co. - Highway 83

Houston made a motion to approve the following "Class B" Intoxicating Liquor and Fermented Malt Beverage License's with the standard liquor license conditions and the condition that the outside area on the east side of the building hours Sunday- Thursday outside hours until 10 p.m. Friday & Saturday outside hours to 10:30 p.m., seconded by Ross. The motion passed unanimously.

Cornerstone Restaurant- Highway 83

Houston made a motion to approve the following "Class B" Intoxicating Liquor and Fermented Malt Beverage License's with the standard liquor license conditions and the condition Outside seating -Limit of one drink per chair, two per table at one time. Customers must be seated to have a drink., seconded by Morris. The motion passed unanimously.

Discussion/action - Cigarette license Genesee Gas Inc.

Ross made a motion to approve the cigarette license for Genesee Gas Inc., seconded by Morris. The motion passed unanimously.
