

TOWN OF GENESEE
LIQUOR LICENSE HEARING MINUTES
CONDUCTED BY THE TOWN BOARD
June 14, 2021

Chairman Leair called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were Chairman Leair, Town Board Supervisors Ross, Houston, Morris and Schmittinger. Also, Present were Administrator/Planner Herrmann, and Clerk Majeskie.

Chairman Leair read the list of standard conditions for all liquor licenses.

All establishments have these standard conditions for their Liquor License

1. Noise from patrons, entertainment and devices shall be kept at a reasonable level.
2. Any time a written complaint is received by the Town the owner shall be notified by the Town within with a copy of the complaint.
3. If licensee shall fail to comply with, or shall violate any of the above restrictions and conditions, the Town Board may, by resolution, revoke or suspend this license after a revocation hearing and upon due notice to licensee and a determination by the Town Board on the question of revocation.

Discussion/Action – “Class A” Intoxicating and Class “A” Fermented Malt Beverage License Genesee Shell and Liquor

Ross made a motion to approve the license for Genesee Shell and Liquor, seconded by Houston. The motion passed unanimously.

Discussion/Action- “Class B” and “Reserved Class B” Intoxicating Liquor and Class “B” Fermented Malt Beverage License”

The Union House - Highway 83
Wales-Genesee Lions Club- Highway 83
Wern Valley Sportsmen Club - Wern Way
Sideliners Pub and Grill – Commercial Drive
Ten Chimneys Foundation- Depot Road (reserved license)

Ross made a motion to approve the liquor licenses for the Union House, Wales/Genesee Lions Club, Wern Valley Sportsmen Club, Sideliners Pub and Grill and Ten Chimneys foundation, seconded by Houston. The motion passed unanimously.

The following establishments have additional conditions for their Liquor Licenses

Vittles and Vine – Hwy. 83

Additional condition that all consumption of alcoholic beverages on the deck/gazebo and patio area shall cease at 10:00 p.m. Sunday -Thursday and at 10:30 p.m. on Friday and Saturday
Ross made a motion to approve the liquor license for Vittles and Vine, seconded by Houston. The motion passed unanimously.

Ella’s Public House – Highway 18

Additional conditions alcohol may be served during regular team games and tournaments, with no consumption after 11:00 p.m. in the volleyball area sold by licensed Ella’s Public house bartenders only, from the container east of Mickle Road. Subject to site plan and plan of operations being

approved by the Town of Genesee Plan Commission. Alcoholic beverages covered under this license may be transported from the main building to the volleyball area.

Ross made a motion to approve the liquor license for Ella's Public House, seconded by Houston. The motion passed unanimously.

InCahoots and Co. - Highway 83

Additional conditions that the outside area on the east side of the building hours is Sunday- Thursday outside hours until 10 p.m. Friday & Saturday outside hours to 10:30 p.m.

Ross made a motion to approve the liquor license for InCahoots and Co., seconded by Houston. The motion passed unanimously.

Cornerstone Restaurant- Highway 83

Additional conditions Outside seating -Limit of one drink per chair, two per table at one time. Customers must be seated to have a drink

Ross made a motion to approve the liquor license for Cornerstone Restaurant, seconded by Houston. The motion passed unanimously.

Discussion/Action - Cigarette license – Genesee Shell and Liquor

Ross made a motion to approve the cigarette license, seconded by Houston. The motion passed unanimously.

Discussion/Action- Operator Permit Applications

Ross made a motion to approve all of the operator permits from the list below, subject to the schooling being turned in from a couple of the operators. All fees have been paid, seconded by Houston. The motion passed unanimously.
